



Electrician/Instrument Technician

Texas Lehigh Cement Company LP has an immediate opening for an Electrician/Instrument Technician at our plant in Buda, Texas. This is an hourly position that will typically work day shift, Monday through Friday.

MAJOR DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Response to emergency callouts and some overtime are requirements of the position.
- Utilize testing tools such as multi-meter and meg-ohmmeter.
- Use of small hand tools required to troubleshoot and repair electrical systems such as motor controls, low and medium voltage power, transformers, lighting and various safety devices.
- Maintaining and repairing instruments such as but not limited to gas analyzers, continuous emissions, and opacity monitors.
- Installing, troubleshooting, repairing temperature, pressure devices, mass weigh systems and all types of controllers.
- Troubleshooting of PLC control circuits and I/O drops, communication systems for data and control systems is required.

KNOWLEDGE/SKILL/ABILITIES REQUIRED

- Ability to read and understand electrical drawings, schematics, installation/instruction manuals for both installing and troubleshooting AC/DC drives, controls is a must.
- Experience in heavy industrial environments is preferred.
- The prospective candidate must also demonstrate a history of safety awareness, safe work practices, excellent attendance, positive attitude and the ability to work alone or in a team environment.
- Pre-employment testing is required.
