Position Description

Position: **Heavy Equipment Mechanic**

General Description:

The Heavy Equipment Mechanic will report directly to the Mobile Shop Leadman. This position will be responsible for the repair, service, and maintenance of equipment in the shop and in the field. This will include troubleshooting and repairing diesel, hydraulic, electrical, and mechanical equipment.

Physical Job Requirements:

Work in and out of shop in elements and dirty environment.

Climb ladders and stairs.

Work extended hours and participate on a Callout schedule.

Requires the ability to stand for up to 8 hours per day, lift 50-80 pounds from the floor to waist height frequently and to push/pull 110 pounds for up to 50 feet consistently.

Must be capable of climbing, kneeling, twisting and bending in a varied environment

Essential Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Must exhibit a high level of safety consciousness and a clear understanding of equipment safety

Must be well versed in all safety aspects of operating & working on mobile equipment

5+ years' experience as a heavy equipment/diesel mechanic

Read and interpret equipment specifications and manuals

Ability to safely use hand and power tools, equipment, and diagnostic devices

Ability to understand and fill out service-related documents and paperwork

Vocational Training and/or Technical Certificate or equivalent

Must be able to perform basic computer operations

Must be able to work with minimum supervision

Experienced in welding and small fabrication

General mechanical knowledge and willingness to learn and ask for help when needed

Roles and Responsibilities:

Troubleshoot engine transmission, hydraulics, drive axle, and electrical problems on a wide array of mobile equipment including the following; CAT loaders, forklifts, grader, D9L dozer, Komatsu haul trucks, light duty pickups, Kawasaki mules, Tennant sweepers, welding machines and a JLG man lift.

Service equipment as required to ensure proper operating condition at the job site

Satisfy in a timely manner, all required documentation, timesheets, checklists, receiving records and repair order logs

Conduct preventative maintenance as required to ensure the timely and accurate completion of preventative maintenance activities

Perform other duties as assigned by the Mobile Supervisor or authorized personnel

Maintain and update equipment records by entering data into MP2

Documentation of PM reports & equipment repair log

Must have general knowledge of computers and able to use Microsoft Excel and Word.

Read technical publications and schematic diagrams to troubleshoot and fix engines, transmissions, front and rear differentials, steering, air and hydraulic brakes, suspensions, clutches and hydraulic cylinders.

Ensure all mobile equipment meets Federal Safety Regulations as it pertains to MSHA part 30 CFR for metal & nonmetal mines
