## JOB DESCRIPTION

**Job Title:** Maintenance Technician

**Department:** Maintenance

**Job Type:** Full-time; Hourly

**Reports to:** Maintenance III Supervisor

### General Description:

The Maintenance Technician will report directly to the Maintenance III Supervisor. This position will be responsible for carrying out all aspects of equipment inspections, repairs, & lubrication including executing planned preventive routes, troubleshooting failures, repairs & housekeeping of assigned equipment. In particular, this technician will initially focus on collecting vibration data and inspection of the clinker cooler pneumatic and conveyor systems.

### Qualifications:

#### Mechanical Skills:

- Basic Mechanical knowledge.
- Basic alignment understanding.
- Able to understand technical specification with respect to equipment installation and operation.
- Welding, cutting, rigging.
- Understand material handling, operation, and trouble shooting.
- Good understanding of pneumatics & hydraulics.

#### Competencies:

- High level of safety consciousness.
- Good communication skills.
- Planning and Organization Skills.
- Detail oriented.
- Problem solving, troubleshooting skills.
- Energetic & self-motivated.
- Able to work with minimum supervision.
- Must be able to perform basic computer operations.
- Ability to safely use hand & power tools, equipment & diagnostic devices.

### Major Duties/Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the housekeeping and safety of the workplace.
- Responsible for repairs in the field and reporting back to supervisor.
- Participate in call out rotation.
- Perform mechanical maintenance activities, makes repairs, minor installations and replacements.
- Perform NOT (non-destructive testing).
- Perform condition monitoring activities.
- Troubleshoot mechanical breakdowns.
- Collect and read vibration data using AMS 2140 hardware and software. (Training will be provided)

**Required Skills/Abilities:**

- Work in and out of the shop in all weather conditions.
- Climb ladders and stairs.
- Work extended hours performing preventive & corrective repairs of assigned plant equipment.
- After hours Call Out Schedule
- Requires the ability to stand for up to 8-16 hours per day, lift 50-80 pounds from the floor to waist height frequently and to push/pull 110 pounds for up to 50 feet consecutively.
- Must be capable of climbing, kneeling, twisting and bending in a varied environment.
